Transportation Services has been requested by Ward 20 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the June 5, 2025, Scarborough Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

## Summary

## Draft Recommendations

- 1. Scarborough Community Council amend the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times, on both sides of Raleigh Avenue, between Kennedy Road and a point 30 metres west of Glasgow Avenue, to be in effect between Kennedy Road and Glasgow Avenue.*
- 2. Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Raleigh Avenue, between North Bonnington Avenue and Glasgow Avenue*
- 3. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the north side of Raleigh Avenue, between North Bonnington Avenue and Glasgow Avenue.*
- 4. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the south side of Raleigh Avenue, between Glasgow Avenue and a point 40 metres west.*
- 5. Scarborough Community Council prohibit standing at all times on the south side of Raleigh Avenue, between a point 40 metres south of Glasgow Avenue and a point 40 metres further west.*
- 6. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the south side of Raleigh Avenue, between a point 140 metres south of Glasgow Avenue and a point 26 metres further west.*
- 7. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the south side of Raleigh Avenue, between a point 280 metres south of Glasgow Avenue and North Bonnington Avenue.*

8. *Scarborough Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Moira Avenue, between Raleigh Avenue and North Bonnington Avenue.*
9. *Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the north side of Moira Avenue, between Raleigh Avenue and North Bonnington Avenue.*

Transportation Services reviewed the feasibility of amending the existing parking regulations on Raleigh Avenue and Moira Avenue in response to concerns raised by residents and the Toronto Police Service – Parking Enforcement Unit. These concerns relate to illegal parking, as well as changes to driveway access points resulting from the redevelopment of a commercial property on the south side of Raleigh Avenue. The review determined that implementing more restrictive parking regulations is feasible. These changes would help deter illegal parking and support safe access for large trucks entering and exiting the commercial driveways. Given the progress of the redevelopment and the ongoing complaints about illegal parking, the Ward Councillor has decided to present the proposed by-law amendments as a new business item at the June meeting of the Scarborough Community Council.

### **Financial Impact**

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$5,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Scarborough Community Council.
