Re: 2025-SC25.29 Temporary Closure of Dowry Street

Our Agincourt community is very much in support of Councillor Mantas recommendation for the temporary closure to vehicular traffic between a point 15 metres west of the east end of Dowry Street and a point 44.1 metres further west.

This entry point to Agincourt GO Station is being used by drivers to drop off commuters however the street provides no space for turn around. Thus, it is very dangerous for pedestrians and commuters who are walking to catch a train while the drivers are backing up in a confined area to turn around. This is extremely unsafe and is a situation for accidents to happen!

Agincourt GO Station provides a Kiss & Ride at the Station; commuters can be dropped off at Lamont/Sheppard and take a stairway to the platform; commuters can be dropped off on Reidmount to walk into the station; commuters can walk a pathway from Agincourt Drive/Lockie Avenue; or commuters can walk the area of Dowry that will be closed to vehicles.

There are plenty of safe alternative to access Agincourt GO Station without being driven directly to the door step on Dowry Avenue!
