SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend to City Council the appointment of a Council Member to fill a vacancy on the Board of Health, resulting from the resignation of Councillor Parthi Kandavel from the Board.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of one Member of Council to the Board of Health for a term of office until November 14, 2026, and until a successor is appointed.

DECISION HISTORY

City Council, at its meeting on December 17 and 18, 2024, appointed Members of Council to the Board of Health.
