### **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to recommend to City Council the appointment of a Council Member to fill a vacancy on the Association of Municipalities of Ontario Board of Directors, resulting from the resignation of Councillor Jennifer McKelvie from the Board.

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of one Member of Council to the Association of Municipalities of Ontario Board of Directors for a term of office until November 14, 2026, and until a successor is appointed.
