Amended Recommendation:

Approve TAF to provide an unfunded guarantee not exceeding \$3.5 million of the repayment by the borrowing company (the "Borrower") of a term loan made to it by the lending party and affiliates (the "Lender") of no greater than 4 years length ("Guarantee"), subject to the following conditions:

- The Lender shall have agreed to lend to the Borrower not less than \$3.5 M as a working capital loan facility upon the terms described in the Direct Investment Request of June 18, 2025 ("Memo") and upon such additional terms as may be consistent therewith as are approved by VP Impact Investing;
- ii) the terms of the Guarantee shall provide for a minimum total return to TAF, outlined in the Memo, of the amount of the Guarantee through a combination of fees and warrant consideration, the aggregate value of which is to be



determined by the VP Impact Investing as meeting that requirement by using the methods set out in the Memo; and

iii) satisfactory review of all legal documentation by TAF's legal counsel, as determined by the VP Impact Investing and the Chief Executive Officer.

 relates to financial institutions publicly pulling away from sustainability
 commitments.
 - It was noted that from discussions with these institutions, they've indicated retaining some of the sustainable finance allocations even if they're not publicly announced.
 - Emphasis was put on how to mobilize capital from financial institutions on retrofitting financing.
 - Committee members indicated that discussions with institutions have seen them express interest into impact investing, opening potential coinvestment opportunities for TAF.
- The Committee also discussed developments as it relates to recent regulatory and policy changes regarding green standards and greenwashing.
 - The committee noted the Competition Bureaus' greenwashing bill has been released and should be noted by staff and the committee.
 - The committee requested further information from the investment team on the greenwashing rules if they see any updates.
