REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The attachment to this report contains financial information supplied in confidence to the Toronto Atmospheric Fund which, if disclosed, could reasonably be expected to prejudice significantly the competitive position or interfere significantly with the contractual or other negotiations of a person, group of persons, or organization.

SUMMARY

This report recommends approval of five grants with a combined value of \$848,077.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Senior Grants Manager recommends that the Board of Directors of the Toronto Atmospheric Fund:

- 1. Approve the grant requests summarized in Confidential Attachment 1, which includes grants recommended for approval and project descriptions.
- 2. Decline the grant request summarized in Confidential Attachment 2, and receive the rationale for partial funding decisions, including original requested amounts.
- 3. Authorize the public release of Confidential Attachment 1 only for grants approved by the Board, and direct that confidential information on any declined grants remain confidential, as it contains financial information, supplied in confidence to The Atmospheric Fund, which, if disclosed, could reasonably be expected to prejudice significantly the competitive position or interfere significantly with the contractual or other negotiations of a person, group of persons, or organization.
- 4. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 2 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains financial information, supplied in confidence to The Atmospheric Fund, which, if disclosed, could reasonably be expected to prejudice significantly the competitive position or interfere

significantly with the contractual or other negotiations of a person, group of persons, or organization.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

If the recommended grants are approved, \$550,086 would be funded from TAF's 2025 grants budget, \$254,881 from the 2026 budget, and \$43,110 from the 2027 budget.

DECISION HISTORY
