RE: Installation of Speed Bumps on Public Laneway South of Davenport Road East of Salem Avenue

Dear Chair and Members of Toronto and East York Community Council,

Speeding vehicles travelling down the public laneway south of Davenport Road and east of Salem Avenue has been a constant issue for residents in the neighbourhood. With residents and their families in this laneway, there have been many unfortunate experiences involving dangerous drivers.

In a neighbourhood survey conducted by my office, residents in the area overwhelmingly confirmed their support for the installation of traffic calming measures that will reduce speeding and improve safety.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of speed bumps in the public lane south of Davenport Road, east of Salem Avenue (north-south branch), between lane south of Davenport Road, east of Salem Avenue North (east-west branch) and the south end, as shown on Drawing No. TC-393, dated November 2024, from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
