**Parking Amendments – Palace Street, between Cooperage Street and Tannery Road**

I am writing to request parking amendments to Palace Street to reduce frequent incidents of congestion on Palace Street. In consultation with local residents, Toronto Police Services and as part of a larger traffic review across Ward 13, turning the “no parking” regulation on the south side to “no standing” will allow for smoother travel on Palace Street.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Palace Street, between a point 9 metres east of Cooperage Street and a point 9 metres west of Tannery Road.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit standing at all times on the south side of Palace Street, between a point 9 metres east of Cooperage Street and a point 9 metres west of Tannery Road.
