Re: Traffic Calming (Speed Humps) - Stanhope Avenue

Transportation Services has been requested by Ward 14 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the May 1, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

- Staff **support** the draft recommendations provided below
- Staff **do not support** the draft recommendations provided below
- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Stanhope Avenue between O'Connor Drive and Hopedale Avenue.*
2. *Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install four speed humps on Stanhope Avenue between O'Connor Drive and Hopedale Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-169, dated September 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.*

At its meeting on October 18, 2023, Toronto and East York Community Council adopted Item TE8.30, a report titled Traffic Calming (Speed Humps) – Stanhope Avenue. Transportation Services recommended that traffic calming not be installed on Stanhope Avenue, as the assessments indicated the warrant criteria set out in the City of Toronto's Traffic Calming Policy had not been met. In March 2025, staff were requested to prepare the recommended wording to support the installation of traffic calming measures on Stanhope Avenue, to be submitted the May meeting of Toronto and East York Community Council. Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$16,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating OR Capital Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
