Re: Parking Amendments – Browning Avenue
Wards: Ward 14, Toronto - Danforth

Transportation Services has been requested by Ward 14 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the June 5, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

Draft Recommendations

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Browning Avenue between Pape Avenue and a point 141.3 metres west of Pape Avenue*
2. *Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on both sides of Browning Avenue, from Logan Avenue and a point 54.1 metres east of Carlaw Avenue.*
3. *Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the odd (south) side of Browning Avenue, from Pape Avenue to the south former Borough of East York limit.*
4. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize permit parking to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the even (north) side of Browning Avenue, from Logan Avenue to Pape Avenue.*
5. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize permit parking to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily, except no parking 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday from a point 30 metres west of Pape Avenue and a point 9 metres further west, on the odd (south) side of Browning Avenue, from Logan Avenue to Pape Avenue.*

Transportation Services has reviewed the feasibility of amending the existing parking regulations on Browning Avenue, between Carlaw Avenue and Pape Avenue, in response to a petition submitted to the Ward Councillor's office and signed by

affected households. The petition requested the removal of the existing parking prohibition on the north side of Browning Avenue, thereby allowing permit parking on both sides of the street. Our review determined that parking is feasible on both sides. The proposed changes would increase the number of available permit parking spaces along this section of Browning Avenue.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$2,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
