Re: Parking Amendments – Boulton Avenue
Wards: Ward 14, Toronto - Danforth

Transportation Services has been requested by Ward 14 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the July 8, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

Draft Recommendations

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing school bus loading zone, in effect from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the west side of Boulton Avenue between a point 30.5 metres south of Dundas Street East and a point 28 metres further south, to be in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive.*
2. *Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing maximum 10-minute parking regulation, in effect from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the west side of Boulton Avenue between a point 58.5 metres south of Dundas Street East and a point 25.5 metres further south, to be in effect from 8:15 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive.*
3. *Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing parking prohibition, in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the west side of Boulton Avenue between a point 58.5 metres south of Dundas Street East and a point 25.5 metres further south, to be in effect from 8:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, except public holidays from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive.*

4. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. all times except no parking anytime from a point 30.1 metres north of Clark Street to a point 6.8 metres further north on the even (west) side of Boulton Avenue, from Clark Street to Dundas Street East.

5. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize permit parking to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 8:00a.m. daily on the even (west) side of Boulton Avenue, from Clark Street to Dundas Street East.

Transportation Services has reviewed the feasibility of amending the existing parking regulations on Boulton Avenue, between Dundas Street East and Clark Street, in response to a request submitted to the Ward Councillor's office by Dundas Junior Public School and School Trustee. The proposed changes to the School Bus Loading Zone and 10-minute Pick-Up/Drop-Off Zone hours are expected to improve safety for students and benefit the broader community.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$1,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
