Re: All-Way Stop Controls – Leuty Avenue and Alfresco Lawn
Wards: Ward 19, East York - Beaches

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 19 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the July 8, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize an all-way compulsory stop control at the intersection of Leuty Avenue and Alfresco Lawn.*

Transportation Services reviewed the feasibility of implementing all-way stop controls at the intersection of Leuty Avenue and Alfresco Lawn in response to a petition submitted to the Ward Councillor's office, signed by nearby residents. The petition requested the installation of all-way stop control to facilitate the addition of pedestrian crosswalks at the intersection. While the June 2022 investigation found that all-way stop controls were not numerically warranted at the time, the proximity of the park and beach has raised community concerns about pedestrian safety. In light of recently updated policies including the all-way stop control justification policy, Transportation Services can support proceeding with this request, as the proposed changes would help mitigate potential conflicts between road users and enhance overall safety at this location.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$1,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing

priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
