**Re: Speed Humps on Pape Avenue between Gerrard Street East and Austin Avenue**

Dear Councillor Moise and Toronto and East York Community Council,

Residents on Pape Avenue, between Gerrard Street East and Austin Avenue, have raised concerns about speeding vehicles on their local street. This area falls within Metrolinx's Ontario Line work zone, where major construction is underway and traffic volumes are expected to increase.

Residents have reported that construction-related activity in the surrounding area has contributed to higher traffic volumes and speeding, impacting both safety and quality of life. In response to these concerns, my office conducted a community ballot to assess support for traffic calming measures.

The results confirmed strong support from local residents for the installation of speed humps on Pape Avenue. These measures aim to reduce vehicle speeds and enhance pedestrian and community safety while significant transit infrastructure work continues nearby.

**Recommendations:**

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Pape Avenue between Gerrard Street East and Austin Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install three speed humps on Pape Avenue between Gerrard Street East and Austin Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-548, dated August 2025 from the Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services.
