Dear Chair and Members,

Re: Speed Humps and Safety Improvements – Benlamond Avenue (Between Main St and Norwood Rd)

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about pedestrian safety on Benlamond Avenue and on surrounding neighbourhood streets. Our office has received a petition from residents in support of the installation of speed humps on Benlamond Avenue (between Main St and Norwood Rd) in January 2025. My office directed staff to prepare a report to Toronto & East York Community Council to authorize the installation. Unfortunately, this action was not completed.

Therefore, I am requesting staff to report back to our next Community Council meeting with the required details to authorize the installation of speed humps on Benlamond Avenue and to report back the feasibility of accelerating additional road safety improvements.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council request the Director, Enforcement and Street Management, to come forward with Recommendations and drawings for traffic calming measures (speed humps) on Benlamond Avenue, between Main Street and Norwood Road, for submission at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting taking place on October 22, 2025.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the Director, Planning, Design & Management, Transportation Services to investigate feasibility of interim geometric safety improvements at the intersection of Benlamond Avenue and Norwood Road / Glen Oak Drive for implementation in 2026.
