Re: St. Clair Avenue West, Parking Amendments (Ward 9, Davenport)

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 9 Councillor to provide wording for recommendations they plan to present to the September 18, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

Draft Recommendations

1. *City Council rescind the parking prohibition in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday, except public holidays, on the south side of St. Clair Avenue West, between a point 57 metres east of Via Italia and a point 15.9 metres east.*

A loading zone has been signed on the south side of St. Clair Avenue West, east of Via Italia. This area is by-lawed as no parking during the subject times. The original applicant has moved and no longer requires the loading zone. The Councillor's office contacted the Corso Italia Business Improvement Areas (BIA) and confirmed none of their members continue to rely on the loading zone. The removal of the signed loading zone will return this section to on-street parking. This will provide approximately three additional on-street parking spaces in the subject section of St. Clair Avenue West.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations will be approximately \$300.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets.

Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the Councillor and approved by City Council.
