

## **Accessible Parking Spaces - October 2025 (Delegated)**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval for the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Attachment 1 and attached to the report entitled "Accessible Parking Spaces - October 2025 (Delegated)", dated October 3, 2025, from the Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council amend parking regulations required in Chapter 950, as generally described in Attachment 2 - Technical Amendments.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

The signage costs associated with the proposed installation/removal of accessible parking spaces is approximately \$8,000.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2025 Operating Budget.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

---

This report addresses a new initiative.

## **COMMENTS**

---

Transportation Services provides designated on-street accessible parking as a convenience for people with disabilities and/or those who transport them, making it easier for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing walking distances.

Designated on-street accessible parking spaces are not for the exclusive use of any one resident. Any person with a valid Accessible Parking Permit issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario (MTO) may park in any designated on-street accessible parking space. Designated on-street accessible parking spaces may be relocated for technical or operational reasons, if deemed necessary by the City.

Delays in installing on-street accessible parking spaces may create hardships for the applicants. Timely removal of a designated on-street accessible parking space when it is no longer needed, for instance when the resident moves or is no longer eligible, aids in maximizing available on-street parking for other residents/motorists.

To be eligible for on-street accessible parking, applicants must hold a valid Accessible Parking Permit, issued by the MTO. Staff have determined that the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces, as listed in Attachment 1, is feasible as the requirements are met and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one on-street parking space for general use.

### **Housekeeping Issues**

Transportation Services discovered discrepancies between the by-lawed parking regulations and the posted signage for some of the subject street corridors. Attachment 2 will rectify these inconsistencies and requires no changes to posted signage.

The Ward Councillors have been advised of the recommendations in this report.

Table 1: On-Street Accessible Parking Spaces to be Installed

Ward	Location
9	Alma Avenue, south side, between a point 46 metres west of Gladstone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west
9	Brock Avenue, east side, between a point 75.5 metres south of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further south, each Thursday from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Brock Avenue, west side, between a point 83 metres south of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further south, anytime, except each Thursday from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
9	Norton Avenue, south side, between a point 35.5 metres east of St. Clair Gardens and a point 5.5 metres further east
11	Roxborough Street West, south side, between a point 42.5 metres east of Avenue Road and a point 5.5 metres further east
14	Cadorna Avenue, east side, between a point 89 metres south of Cosburn Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south
14	Stanhope Avenue, east side, between a point 104 metres north of O'Connor Drive and a point 5.5 metres further north, during the months of January, February, March, April, June, August, October, and December
14	Stanhope Avenue, west side, between a point 107 metres north of O'Connor Drive and a point 5.5 metres further north, during the months of May, July, September, and November
19	Cedarvale Avenue, west side, between a point 142.5 metres north of Strathmore Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further north

4	Medland Street, west side, between a point 69 metres north of Annette Street and a point 5.5 metres further north

Norton Avenue	North	A point 45.7 metres west of Dufferin Street and St. Clair Gardens	Anytime, except the 1st Wednesday and 3rd Wednesday of each month, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
Norton Avenue	South	A point 45.7 metres west of Dufferin Street and St. Clair Gardens	Anytime, on the 1st Wednesday and 3rd Wednesday of each month, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
