

Rescinding appointments made in error to the Community Centre 55 Board of Management

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend that Toronto and East York Community Council rescind appointments to the Community Centre 55 Board of Management made on July 8, 2025 in Item TE24.74. The Community Centre 55 Board of Management had submitted a letter to Toronto and East York Community Council (June 20, 2025) requesting the appointments however, the letter was submitted in error as the Board of Management already had its full complement of members.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Manager recommends that the Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Rescind the appointments of Natalie Johnson and Pauline Grant to the Community Centre 55 Board of Management, made in TE24.74.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial impacts resulting from the recommendations in this report.

DECISION HISTORY

Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting on July 8, 2025 adopted the appointment of Natalie Johnson and Pauline Grant to the Community Centre 55 Board of Management.

COMMENTS

Community Centre 55 (CC55) is a local and city board under the City of Toronto Act, 2006, which operates under the Association of Community Centres (AOCCs) Relationship Framework and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 25, Community and Recreation Centres (Chapter 25). CC55 is one of 10 AOCC boards that operate in accordance with the Relationship Framework and Chapter 25.

According to Schedule 5 of the Relationship Framework, the Board of Management for CC55 (CC55 Board) shall be composed of seven members: six persons who are appointed by Community Council and the Councillor for Beaches - East York (Ward 19).

The Community Centre 55 Board of Management had submitted a letter to Toronto and East York Community Council (June 20, 2025) requesting the appointments however, the letter was submitted in error as the Board of Management already had its full complement of members. Attachment 1, Letter from the Acting Executive Director of Community Centre 55 provides a description of the error.

This report recommends correction of the error by rescinding the TEYCC appointments adopted on July 8, 2025. The CC55 Board remains at full capacity in accordance with the Relationship Framework and City of Toronto Public Appointments Policy. The City Manager is responsible for the transmittal of reports related to governance matters.
