Re: Denvale Road - Speed Hump Relocation (Ward 19, Beaches - East York)

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 19 Councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present to the October 22, 2025, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

Draft Recommendations:

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the relocation of an approved speed hump on Denvale Road, between Eden Park Road and Ashall Boulevard, generally as set out in Drawings No's. TC-156 and TC-157, dated January 2025, attached to the motion entitled "Denvale Road – Speed Hump Relocation".*

Six speed humps were approved on Denvale Road by Toronto and East York Community Council in September 2023. The Toronto and East York Community Council decision can be found at:

The speed humps have not been installed yet on Denvale Road due to reported concerns with their locations.

Speed hump locations are determined using established criteria to ensure safety, proper spacing, and clearance from driveways and other infrastructure. Traffic calming measures are implemented for the benefit of the entire community, prioritizing safety and consistency over individual requests. Staff do not support relocations based on

individual preferences. Changes to approved locations can undermine the intent of these initiatives and set a challenging precedent.

After the speed hump approval on Denvale Road, the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, requested that two of the six approved speed humps on Denvale Road be relocated. The request was reviewed and, although not preferred, an alternative location was identified as feasible for one of the speed humps identified as a concern. The second relocation request could not be accommodated due to physical site constraints.

Financial Impact

The estimated cost for installing six speed humps on Denvale Road is \$24,000.00. Since the installation of the originally approved speed humps had been put on hold, relocating one of the speed humps will not result in additional costs.
