Naming of a Public Lane Located West of Claremont Street, extending between Mansfield Avenue and Treford Place

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the name "Love You More Lane" be approved to identify the naming of a public lane located west of Claremont Street, extending between Mansfield Avenue and Treford Place.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Engineering and Construction Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Approve the name "Love You More Lane" for naming of a public lane located west of Claremont Street, extending between Mansfield Avenue and Treford Place

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost to install street name signage is approximately \$600 and is included within the Transportation Services Division's Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This is the first time that this issue is before Community Council.

COMMENTS

An application was received on August 24, 2020, requesting the naming of a public lane located west of Claremont Street, extending between Mansfield Avenue and Treford Place to "Love You More Lane." The name "Love You More Lane" portrays a strong positive image of the heritage of the community. Extending this sentiment to the laneway creates a strong social contribution to the community, fostering a sense of love and welcoming that are the foundations of a strong, thriving, and growing community.

The following background and rationale were provided by the applicant:

Love You More Lane

A member of the community's great grandmother always finished her goodbyes with a "love you more". The sentiment of this farewell and the decision to propose it for the laneway name comes from a place of love and caring for the neighborhood and community. In such a multigenerational neighbourhood (several community members have been living in their homes since the 1960s), we thought that this expression was a beautiful way to recognize and celebrate that unique aspect of our community. With many new children in the neighbourhood, this name also describes the strong community love and spirit we wish future generations to be welcomed into.

The proposed name has been circulated for comment and is acceptable to Toronto Police Service, Toronto Fire Services, and Toronto Paramedic Services.

Councillor Dianne Saxe, Ward 11 University-Rosedale, supports this naming.

Community support was demonstrated with a petition of signatures from the local community.

Community Councils have delegated authority to decide street naming matters which comply with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy.
