Re: Traffic Calming – Hatherley Road, between Eversfield Road and Harvie Avenue (Ward 9, Davenport)

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 9 Councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present to the November 27, 2025 Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

Draft Recommendations

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (six speed humps) on Hatherley Road, between Eversfield Road and Harvie Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawings No's. TC-618 and TC-618-1, dated November 2025 from the Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services.*
2. *Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north and east sides of Hatherley Road, between the west end of Hatherley Road and Eversfield Road.*
3. *Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the west and south sides of Hatherley Road, between a point 30.7 metres north of Eversfield Road and a point 30 metres north and west thereof.*
4. *Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking to be effect at all times on the south and west sides of Hatherley Road, between the west end of Hatherley Road and Eversfield Road.*
5. *Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking to be effect at all times on the north and east sides of Hatherley Road, between a point 60 metres north of Eversfield Road and Woodcroft Crescent.*

6. *Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking to be effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., daily, on the north side of Hatherley Road, between a point 15 metres west of Ennerdale Road and a point 42 metres further west.*

The Ward Councillor requested staff to evaluate the feasibility of implementing traffic calming (speed humps) on Hatherley Road, between Eversfield Road and Harvie Avenue, to improve safety for all road users. It is reported that motorists are speeding on the subject street, and the surrounding area experiences a high volume of foot traffic associated with nearby pedestrian generators, which include Charles Caccia Park, B.E.N. School House, Marbel Hill Parkette, and residential neighborhoods.

As the Councillor has indicated they would like to forgo the study process, motorist speed and volume data were not collected, and staff have not evaluated the installation of traffic calming measures (speed humps) on the roadway. Staff conducted a site visit in October 2025 to map the proposed speed hump locations.

During the investigation, Transportation Services discovered discrepancies between the by-lawed parking regulations and the posted signage on Hatherley Road. Recommendations 2 to 6 will rectify these inconsistencies.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, staff expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations above will be approximately \$24,000.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Capital Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the Councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
