Regarding: Item 2025 TE19.34 Yonge and Delisle Traffic Control Signals

Dear Members of Toronto and East York Community Council

The Deer Park Residents Group (“DPRG”) notes that the above item is scheduled for consideration by Community Council on Tuesday, January 14th.

Having reviewed the staff report in support of the proposal to install traffic control signals at the intersection of Yonge and Delisle, DPRG requests that this item be deferred to allow time for discussion with City staff and Councillor Matlow on the design and mitigation of potential unintended consequences of the proposal.

DPRG recognizes the importance of safe pedestrian crossing at this site, particularly in the context of current and potential development at 1 Delisle and the Wittington site. We would appreciate the opportunity to understand the specific proposal for full traffic lights and related changes to Yonge St, discuss implications and potential mitigation and to understand this particular proposal within the broader context of pedestrian safety and traffic management along the stretch of Yonge St between Mount Pleasant cemetery and St Clair Avenue, including the problematic intersection at Yonge and Heath and the intersection of Yonge and St Clair.
