I understand that the topic of traffic safety at Logan Avenue may be discussed at your meeting today. I am writing to express my support for improved traffic safety measures including the installation of speed humps on Logan Avenue between Danforth and McConnell.

As the elected TDSB Trustee for the Toronto-Danforth area, I have heard concerns from many Frankland School families and staff about safety concerns on this stretch of road.

The safety of our students and community members is of utmost importance.

In my view the current traffic conditions on Logan Avenue pose a safety risk, especially when children are being dropped off and picked up from school.

Speed humps would greatly contribute to reducing vehicle speeds and enhancing pedestrian safety.
