Re: City Initiated Zoning By-Law Amendment Application 19 127586 STE 13 OZ 27 Grosvenor Street and 26 Grenville Street

We are in support of the proposed amendment to change the mix of suite types for the rental development at 27 Grosvenor Street and 26 Grenville Street. The addition of 2 affordable housing apartments is important for the community.

About one third of Bay Cloverhill residents are university students or seniors. These demographics would be prime candidates for affordable housing. The majority of buildings are condominium, and more rental stock is always needed.
