Recommendations

It is recommended that the TTC Board:

1. Approve the attached proxy to exercise the 10,000 TTC Shares in TCTI.

Summary

The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC), as the sole shareholder of Toronto Coach Terminal Inc. (TCTI), appoints the Chair of TCTI, or if an alternative is required, the Vice-Chair, as its proxy to vote 10,000 shares on its behalf at any Shareholders meeting held during the year 2026.

Background and Analysis

Each year, the TTC Board appoints a proxy to vote the 10,000 shares at any Shareholder meeting held in the upcoming year.

TCTI (originally Gray Coach) was Toronto's intercity bus terminal located at 610 Bay Street and 130 Elizabeth Street. On June 16, 2021, the TCTI Board approved, upon the expiry of the lease between TCTI and Greyhound and Coach Canada Toronto Operations Ltd., the transfer of the operational management of 610 Bay Street and 130 Elizabeth Street to the City of Toronto, with payment and liability conditions. Although TCTI is no longer responsible for operating the bus terminal, it remains a legal entity as the parent of the Toronto Transit Commission Insurance Company Limited.
