

APPENDIX C

Amendments to Toronto Municipal Code Chapters

The Toronto Municipal Code is comprised of three parts: Part I – Administrative By-laws; Part II – General By-laws; and Part III – Traffic and Parking By-laws. As part of this review, staff examined 71 Municipal Code Chapters within Parts II and III that contain provisions prescribing fines for contraventions. Of these 71 chapters, the maximum allowable fines for 30 are currently set at the COTA maximum of \$100,000 and include provisions for charging officers and directors of a corporation who knowingly concur in the contravention of the chapter. An additional 22 chapters are not recommended for amendment or are excluded from this review for various reasons, including where fines are prescribed by legislation other than COTA, are under active divisional review, have been repealed, or are otherwise considered to have an adequate fine structure.

6. <u>Chapter 470, Fire Safety Boxes</u>	§. 470-11. Offences.	Include provisions to increase maximum fine to \$100,000 as per COTA, 2006 and provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence.
7. <u>Chapter 485, Graffiti</u>	§. 485-8. Offences.	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations.
8. <u>Chapter 517, Idling of Vehicles and Boats</u>	§. 517-3. Offences.	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations.
9. <u>Chapter 546, Licensing of Vehicles for hire</u>	§. 546-120. Offences.	Include provisions to increase the maximum permitted fine for persons and officers/directors of corporations to \$100,000.

11. <u>Chapter 608, Parks</u>	§. 608-54. Penalties and Administrative Penalties	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increase the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations.
12. <u>Chapter 659, Refrigerators and Other Appliances, Abandoned</u>	§. 659-3. Offences.	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors.
13. <u>Chapter 719, Snow and Ice Removal</u>	§ 719-6. Offences.	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations.
14. <u>Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of, excluding Article XII</u>	§ 743-51. Offences and administrative penalties.	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations, excluding contraventions to Article XII of Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Access to Social Infrastructure.

19. <u>Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards</u>	§ 918-28. Offences and Administrative Penalties	Include provisions to provide that a director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of the chapter by the corporation is guilty of an offence and increasing the maximum fine to \$100,000 for both persons and officers/directors of corporations.
