The Toronto Municipal Code, Accountability Officers, s.3-1.6 provides that an accountability officer shall report annually to Council on the activities of his or her office and the discharge of his or her duties.

The City of Toronto Act, 2006, section 168 authorized the City to appoint a Registrar who is responsible for performing in an independent manner, the functions assigned by

City Council with respect to the Registry described in subsection 165 (1) and the system of registration and other matters described in section 166.
