Comments:

Councillor Moise's comments toward a member of the public were not simply a lapse in judgment but a serious breach of public trust. Dismissing or vilifying a constituent for asking a reasonable, budget-related question undermines the very foundation of representative democracy.

The Integrity Commissioner's finding of "discreditable conduct" speaks for itself; however, the absence of a recommended penalty is deeply concerning. **If elected officials face no consequence for behaviour that diminishes public confidence, accountability within City Hall becomes meaningless.**

I urge City Council to take corrective action and impose an appropriate sanction. Such a decision would affirm the City's commitment to respectful civic engagement and to maintaining decorum and integrity in public office. Toronto deserves leadership that exemplifies fairness, humility, and professionalism, and not conduct that alienates community members who seek dialogue in good faith.
