Dear Members of Toronto City Council,

I am writing to express my support for preserving the property at 3100 Weston Road and to ask that Toronto City Council continue to oppose the proposed development application before the Ontario Land Tribunal.

This property has a very important history for the community. For generations, these buildings on the property have served the community as places of worship, heritage, education, prayer and community service. Students, families, seniors and visitors have been enriched by the programs, events and spiritual activities that have taken place there. The buildings include the historic Rivermede House, the former St. Basil-the-Great College School and the Chapel of St. Basil-the-Great.
