REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report is about labour relations or employee negotiations.

SUMMARY

This report seeks Board approval of the negotiated collective agreement with IATSE Local B-173, representing housekeeping staff at the Meridian Arts Centre.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The President and Chief Executive Officer recommends that the Board of Directors of TO Live:

1. Approve the negotiated collective agreement with IATSE Local B-173, as outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.
2. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains labour relations information or employee negotiations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact beyond the matters outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.

DECISION HISTORY

At its March 24, 2026 meeting, the Board of Directors of TO Live approved a bargaining mandate for negotiations with IATSE Local B-173 for housekeeping staff at the Meridian Arts Centre.

IATSE Local B-173 represents housekeeping staff at the Meridian Arts Centre. The bargaining unit currently includes thirteen employees; three full-time and ten part-time.

The previous collective agreement expired on March 31, 2026. Negotiations began on April 30, 2026 and resulted in negotiated terms that are recommended for Board approval.
