I am writing on behalf of the University of Toronto to express our support for the vision to revitalize Queen's Park North. The Weston Foundation's \$50 million philanthropic donation represents a transformational step toward our shared goal: preserving and enhancing Queen's Park North as an extraordinary place for people and nature in every season.

As you know, the University of Toronto, the City of Toronto, and the Weston Foundation are proposing a tri-party maintenance, operations, and funding agreement to support stewardship of the park following construction.
