Please publish this comment. Why are only dead animals collected listed in the 311 data? How does that encourage people to support Toronto Animal Services? Please add in the 311 data all the injured, sick, lost, found, etc animals rescued by Toronto Animal Services, plus outcome data. Mention data on fosters and adoptions, and reunions, on the 311 data, not just the Animal Services data. 311 should also go to a real person, and Toronto Animal Services should have its own number in addition to being accessible through 311, rather than reference back to 311 and no real person right away.
