

Parking Amendments - Caledon Road

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that parking be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on both sides of Caledon Road, between Grenview Boulevard South and Berry Road. The proposed regulation will deter excessive long-term parking on the street and will improve vehicle movements by maintaining a clear passage for vehicles.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Caledon Road, between Grenview Boulevard South and Berry Road.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$400.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2026 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, requested that parking be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Caledon Road, between

Grenview Boulevard South and Berry Road, as a result of vehicles parking on both sides of the roadway creating congestion and impeding two-way traffic.

Existing Conditions

Caledon Road is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, north-south, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 7 metres
- The speed limit is 30 km/h
- Heavy trucks are prohibited at all times
- There is no TTC service provided
- There are no sidewalks on either side of the street

The land use is comprised of single-family residential dwellings. The subject section of Caledon Road is not within a designated Community Safety Zone.

The unsigned statutory three-hour maximum parking limit is in effect at all times on both sides of Caledon Road.

Proposed Changes

Parking is currently allowed on both sides of Caledon Road, subject to the unsigned three-hour maximum regulation, the proposed parking regulation will prohibit parking on both sides of Caledon Road from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, allowing for two-way traffic to be maintained. The proposed prohibition will result in a loss of approximately six parking spaces.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendment is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.
