

On-Street Electric Vehicle Charging Stations on Kinsdale Boulevard and The Kingsway - Parking Amendments (Delegated Locations)

SUMMARY

This report outlines the parking by-law amendments required to implement two (2) Electric Vehicle (EV) charging locations on Kinsdale Boulevard and The Kingsway, for the roll out of four (4) charging stations for which this Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. These locations have been reviewed and supported by the local Councillors.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Street Permits, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council designate on-street electric vehicle charging station parking areas at the following locations:
 - a. Kinsdale Boulevard, south side, from a point 61.5 metres east of Park Lawn Road and a point 12 metres further east (2 spaces); and
 - b. The Kingsway, south side, from a point 28.2 metres east of Anglesey Boulevard and a point 12 metres further east (2 spaces)

for the exclusive use of electric vehicles and amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 910, Parking Machines, Parking Metres and Mobile Only Zones and Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, as generally described in Attachment 2 of this report (April 13, 2026).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the installation of the new EV charging stations, including signage and pavement markings will be borne by the Toronto Parking Authority.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative, however, a previous decision is available below which refers to the subject matter:

The Infrastructure and Environment Committee, at its meeting of May 25, 2022 adopted, as amended, Item IE30.11 entitled, "On-Street Electric Vehicle Charging Stations - Pilot Conclusion and Next Steps."

COMMENTS

Transportation Services staff, with the assistance of Toronto Parking Authority and Toronto Hydro, have worked together to identify suitable locations to deploy EV charging stations. One of the two locations identified in this report (i.e., Kinsdale Boulevard) is in a designated permit parking area.

An inventory of locations, identified by staff and through resident outreach were considered and a shortlist of locations were presented to the local Councillors in the Etobicoke York Community Council area. Site selections are determined based on the following criteria:

- In a permit parking area with available permits (i.e., <90% capacity)
- On a street block with at least two fewer permits issued than parking spaces available
- Limited or no daytime parking restrictions or alternate side-of-street parking
- The presence of electric or street light poles located between the curb and sidewalk (considered the boulevard area), directly adjacent to the curb within the sidewalk to support pole-mounted chargers, or positioned behind the sidewalk where power can be accessed to support pedestal chargers
- On a street that allows for the placement of two adjacent parking spaces (single spaces are also acceptable) without encroaching on driveways, intersections, fire hydrants, or other significant encumbrances
- The location provides sufficient electrical capacity and can otherwise support various EV charging station types (e.g., pole-mounted and pedestal chargers)

This report outlines the parking by-law amendments required to implement two (2) EV charging locations to facilitate the roll out of four (4) charging stations for which this Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

New On-Street EV Charging Station Locations on Kinsdale Blvd & The Kingsway

The following locations have been identified and are supported by the local Councillors for the installation in 2026, with the actual locations shown on the map in Attachment 1:

- a. Kinsdale Boulevard, south side, from a point 61.5 metres east of Park Lawn Road and a point 12 metres further east (2 spaces)
- b. The Kingsway, south side, from a point 28.2 metres east of Anglesey Boulevard and a point 12 metres further east (2 spaces)

The designated EV charging station spaces will be subject to any other parking regulations in effect in the area, including the need for an on-street parking permit where and when required. In addition, parking in these spaces will be limited to a twelve (12) hour maximum period for permit parking holders, and three (3) hours maximum period for non-permit parking holders to ensure turn-over, and users must be actively connected at all times.

The site-specific by-law amendments required to implement the new EV parking areas at the locations noted above are detailed in Attachment 2 of this report, with the new regulations taking effect upon installation of the EV charging stations and regulatory signage.

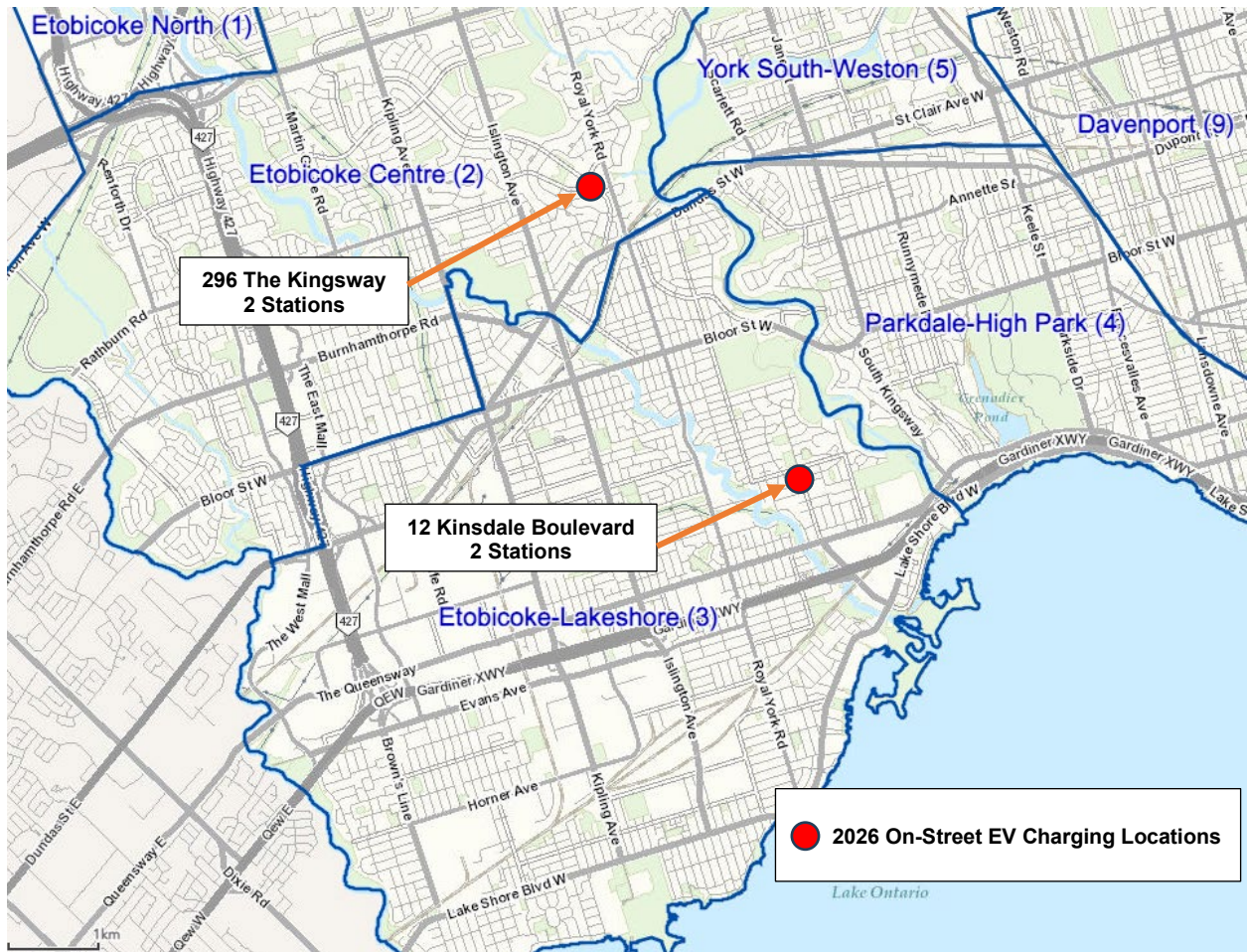
