<b>Parks &amp; Recreation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness with 1 Continuation Visit</b> – (Jul 11) A worker lost consciousness due to heat stress</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Aug 12) A worker sustained a fracture to their right wrist after tripping and falling over obstructions on the gym floor</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Aug 16) A worker lost consciousness after being stung by bees</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Aug 18) A worker lost consciousness due to a personal medical event</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Aug 22) A worker lost consciousness due to heat stress</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Sep 27) A worker lost consciousness due to a medical incident that was not workplace related</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Oct 9) A worker lost consciousness after the worker cut their hand during kitchen preparation for a cooking class</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Oct 21) A person (non-worker) lost consciousness during a cake decorating class - reason unknown</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Nov 28) A worker lost consciousness after they had a seizure which may have been due to a medical condition that was not workplace related</li> </ul>	<b>10</b>

<b>Seniors Services and Long-Term Care</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Mar 31) A worker fractured their right wrist after a slip and fall while entering a building</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (May 15) A worker fractured their lower right leg after a slip and fall outside of a resident’s room</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Dec 2) A worker lost consciousness upon laying down after they struck their finger on a cupboard</li> </ul>	<b>3</b>
<b>Solid Waste Management Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (Jul 4) A worker lost consciousness due to heat stress</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Oct 8) A worker fractured their wrist due to a malfunctioned truck steering wheel</li> </ul>	<b>2</b>
<b>Toronto Court Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Mar 24) A worker fractured their leg after a slip and fall when entering a building</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Sep 25) A worker fractured their right foot after bypassing a two-step stair and subsequent fall to the ground</li> </ul>	<b>2</b>
<b>Toronto Fire Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Feb 24) A worker sustained a fracture to their left elbow after a slip and fall at an emergency call</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Mar 8) A worker sustained a fracture to their ankle while conducting a training exercise, using a high-pressure water hose, and lost their balance</li> <li>• <b>Continuation Visit from May 2024</b> – (Apr 24) Review of training programs</li> <li>• <b>Loss of consciousness</b> – (May 22) A worker lost consciousness after losing their balance while responding to an emergency scene</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Oct 26) A worker sustained a fracture to their ankle after losing their balance while dismounting apparatus</li> </ul>	<b>5</b>
<b>Toronto Paramedic Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>N/A</b> – (Apr 10) A worker sustained a serious medical event - Not workplace related</li> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (May 2) A worker sustained a fracture to their right ankle after rolling it on uneven stone steps and falling at a private residence</li> </ul>	<b>2</b>
<b>Toronto Water</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fracture</b> – (Jan 3) A worker sustained a fracture to their hand after it was crushed by a catch basin lid</li> </ul>	<b>1</b>
