I am writing to support Councillor Pasternak and Councillor Cheng's motion about Rogers Stadium, [MM42.18](#) - Hitting the Right Notes in Downsview: Supporting Toronto's Music Industry While Considering Local Residents.

Noise from Rogers Stadium is more than an annoyance to neighbours. It is harmful to their health. Research is clear that ongoing exposure to unwanted noise causes sleep disruption, stress, cardiovascular disease, hypertension, diabetes, and adverse mental health impacts. The human body has no defense against sound, and noise pollution (unwanted and/or harmful sound) is the second-worst environmental health threat after air pollution according to the World Health Organization. Residents deserve not to be subjected to unwanted noise at their homes.

A vibrant city life is essential, and I support live music events. However, vibrancy for some shouldn't come at a cost to the health of others. It should be possible to hold Live Nation accountable for ensuring the amplified sound from their concerts does not disturb people in proximity to the venue.
