**Re: Lion and Sun Flag Raising in Toronto**

---

I am writing on behalf of the International Center for Human Rights in Canada (ICHRI) to respectfully request your support for a flag-raising ceremony featuring the historic Lion and Sun flag at Toronto City Hall.

In June 2025, I submitted a formal application on behalf of ICHR and the community for this purpose, which was unfortunately not approved. A subsequent application submitted in January 2026 was also declined. While we respect the City's processes, we remain hopeful that this request may be reconsidered in light of its cultural significance and current circumstances.

The Lion and Sun flag represents unity, cultural heritage, history, and shared identity for millions of Iranians worldwide. For Iranian Canadians, it is not merely a political symbol, but a deeply rooted cultural emblem reflecting centuries of art, literature, and tradition. It is consistently displayed at community, cultural, and social events across the Greater Toronto Area.

Recently, more than 150,000 people participated in a march in Toronto from Dundas Square, where participants carried the Lion and Sun flag rather than the flag of the Islamic Republic. This clearly demonstrated which symbol represents the community's collective identity.

Several neighboring municipalities, including Aurora, Richmond Hill, and Vaughan, have approved and hosted official Lion and Sun flag-raising ceremonies in recent days. We respectfully submit that Toronto, as Canada's largest and most diverse city, is well positioned to offer similar recognition and to reconsider this request.

In addition, we respectfully request that the City of Toronto and the Mayor consider inviting Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi to attend the flag-raising ceremony, should this initiative be approved.

Iranian Canadians have made meaningful contributions to Toronto and the GTA in business, education, healthcare, culture, and public life. As an active and engaged community, we value Toronto's longstanding commitment to diversity, inclusion, and respect for heritage communities.

Given the ongoing situation in Iran and its profound emotional, social, and psychological impact on Iranian Canadians, the opportunity to raise this flag at City Hall would serve as a powerful gesture of solidarity, support, and recognition. It would also reflect the City's commitment to human rights and democratic values.
