Re: Dallimore Circle – Parking Amendment | Motion Memorandum
Ward: Ward 16, Don Valley East

Transportation Services has been requested by a local Councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present in a motion to North York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

Draft Recommendations:

1. City council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the east/south side of Dallimore Circle, between a point 59 metres north of Haldenby Terrace (east intersection) and a point 62 metres south of Haldenby Terrace (west intersection).
2. City Council prohibit standing, Monday to Friday, on the south side of Dallimore Circle, between a point 93 metres southwest of Haldenby Terrace (east intersection) and a point 21 metres further southwest.

Dallimore Circle is an 8.5-metre-wide local street. A statutory standing prohibition in effect at all times was recently signed on the south of the street for a TTC bus stop in front of 120 Dallimore Circle. The bus stop services the 403 South Don Mills Community Bus that operates Monday to Friday. Consultation with the TTC revealed that they support the proposed amendment to the times of the standing prohibition in the vicinity of the bus stop.

Cost

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$500. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2026 Interim Operating Budget.
