NOTICE OF MOTION

RE: Implementation of Permit Parking on Rawlinson Avenue between Eglinton Avenue and Broadway Avenue

Dear Chair and Colleagues,

Last year, my office received an initiative with strong support from residents of Rawlinson Avenue, between Eglinton Avenue and Broadway Avenue, for the implementation of on-street permit parking.

Due to the special circumstances of a long-term polling pause, combined with strong petition support, City Council, at its meeting of February 4-5, 2026, approved item NY29.3, regarding an exemption for the implementation of permit parking on Rawlinson Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Broadway Avenue, from the polling requirements of subsection 925-4B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking.

In response to the residents' initiative, I am now moving the implementation of a Permit Parking Area, based on the attached map, created by Transportation Services, reflecting the residents' initiative.

Recommendations:

1. North York Community Council authorize the creation of a newly designated Permit Parking – Area 15A, as attached in Attachment 1, and amend Schedule “B” to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a new permit parking area “15A”.
2. North York Community Council authorize parking by permit only to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily, on the even (west) side of Rawlinson Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Broadway Avenue.
3. North York Community Council rescind the parking prohibition in effect at all times on the west side of Rawlinson Avenue between Eglinton Avenue East and Roehampton Avenue.

4. North York Community Council rescind the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., on the east side of Rawlinson Avenue between Eglinton Avenue East and Roehampton Avenue.
5. North York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the east side of Rawlinson Avenue between Eglinton Avenue East and Roehampton Avenue.
6. North York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum period of 1 hour in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the west side of Rawlinson Avenue between Eglinton Avenue East and Roehampton Avenue.

Background

At its meeting of February 4-5, 2026, City Council approved item NY29.3, regarding an exemption for the implementation of permit parking on Rawlinson Avenue from Eglinton Avenue East to Broadway Avenue, from the requirements of subsection 925-4B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking.

Subsection 925-4B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, provides that:

Where permit parking is not currently available and where a petition requesting permit parking signed by the residents of a minimum of 25% of the total number of residential premises having a residential address on the street or the flank of the street is submitted to the General Manager, a poll shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 190, Polling and Notification, to determine if the residents wish to have permit parking on their road or area, as the case may be. In the event of a positive polling result, the General Manager shall report such result to the appropriate community council, which community council under delegated authority, shall be authorized to pass any necessary by-laws to implement permit parking on the road or area. In the event of a negative result, permit parking shall not be extended to the road or area, and no further permit parking poll shall be conducted for a period of two years



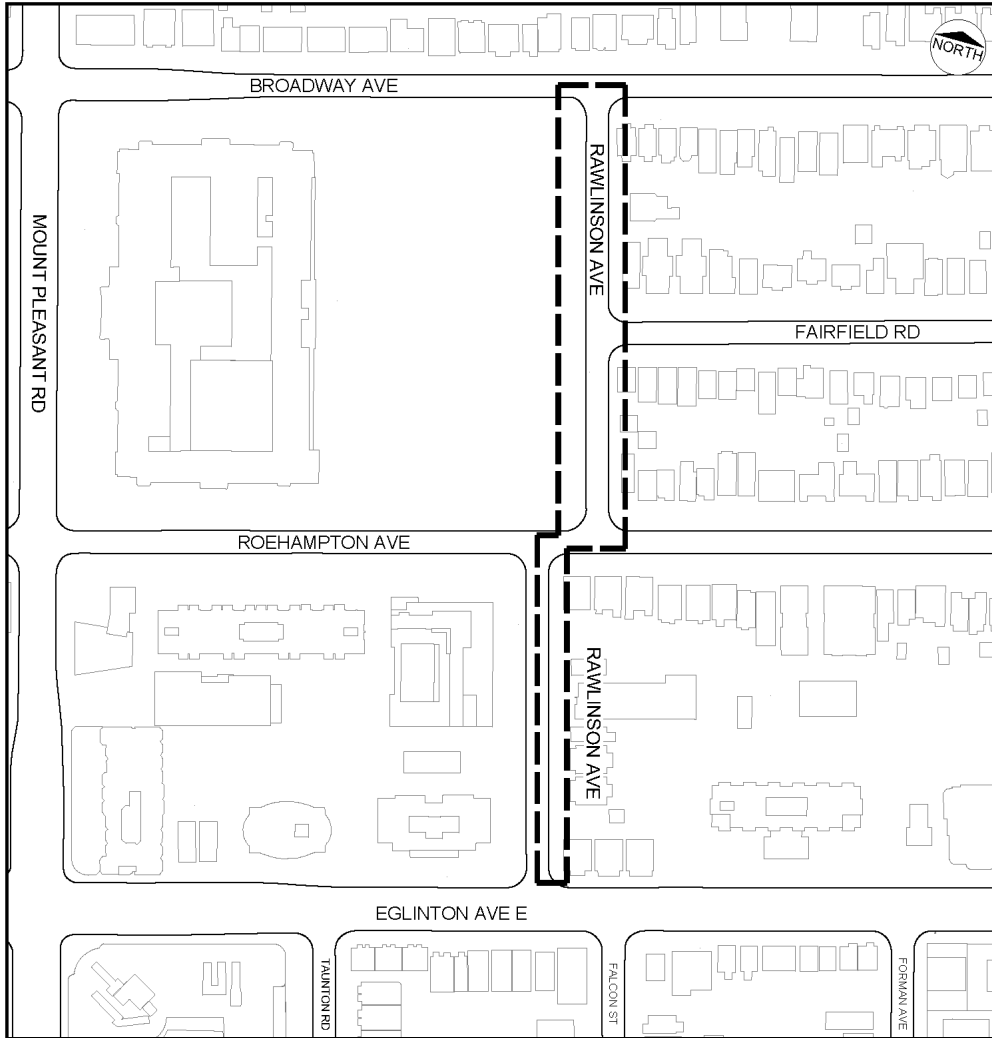
