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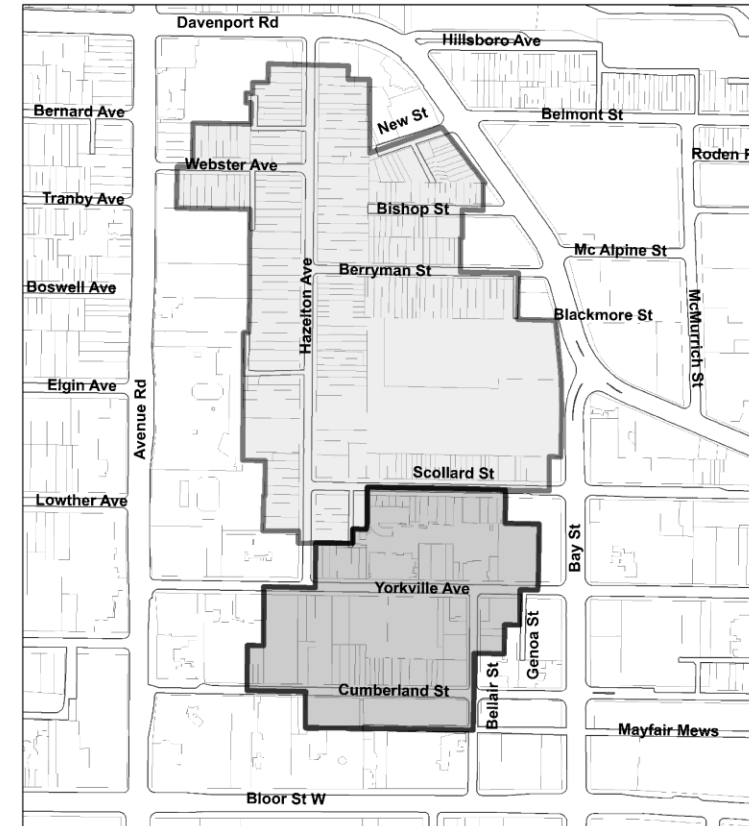
Authorization to Study the Yorkville Village Core as a Potential Heritage Conservation District

July 6, 2026

Proposed Yorkville Village Core HCD Study Area

The proposed Yorkville Village Core HCD Study Area, was recommended for study in the Bloor-Yorkville Cultural Heritage Resource Assessment (December 2025) prepared by Common Bond Collective.

In April 2026, City Council directed the Senior Manager, Heritage Planning to undertake all necessary steps, including community consultation, to determine whether the Yorkville Village Core, or a part thereof, merits authorization for study as a potential Heritage Conservation District under Section 40(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act.

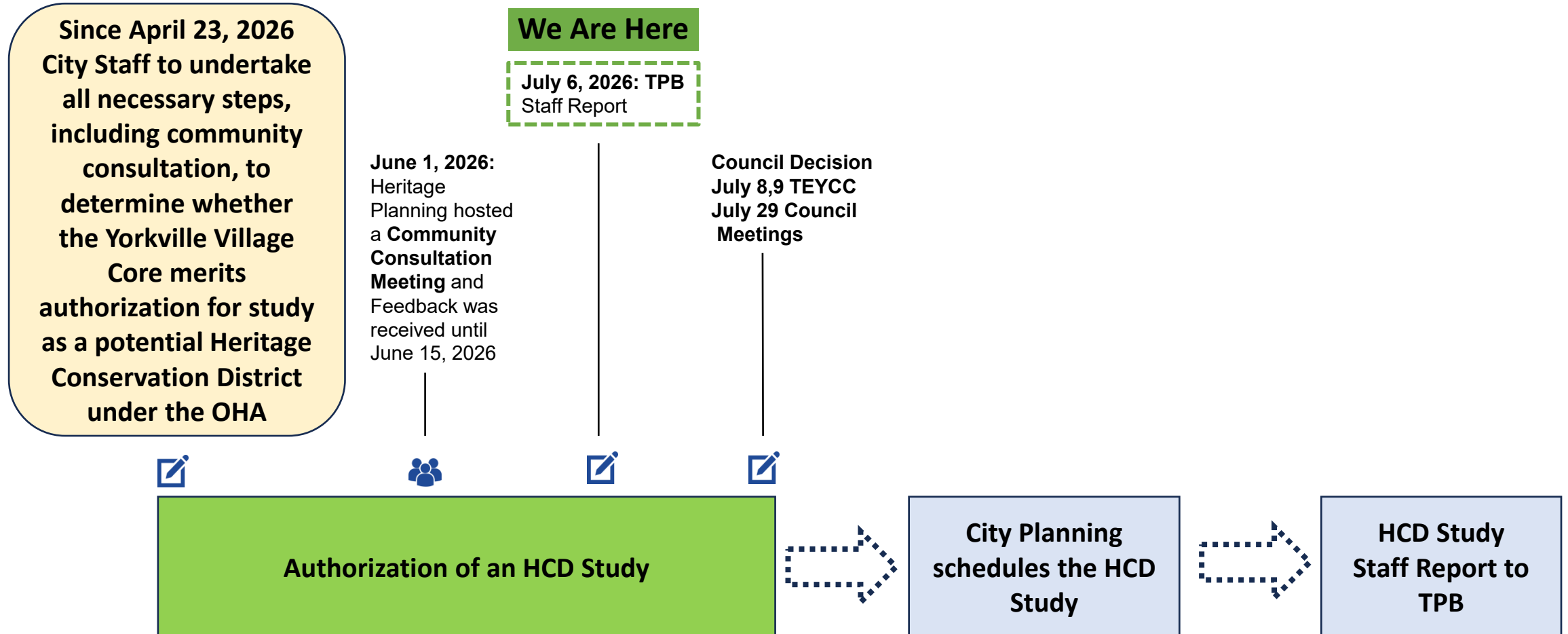

Public Engagement and Community Consultation

June 1, 2026 Community Consultation Meeting (CCM)

- Owners and occupants of properties within the proposed HCD Study Area - invitation to attend meeting hosted by Heritage Planning on June 1, 2026
- Stakeholders and other Interested Parties from the CHRA e.g. Residents' Associations were invited
- 123 participants at the CCM
- 23 written comments collected at the CCM
- Additional comments deadline of June 15, 2026
- Approximately 190 emails received by June 15, 2026

Proposed Yorkville Village Core HCD Study Area

Yorkville Village Core HCD Study Area has a distinctive character that reflects its historical development from a residential area in the 19th century Village of Yorkville to an important locus of cultural expression and innovation in the mid-20th century, into a renowned, vibrant commercial, social, and cultural destination in the City of Toronto today.

Following staff review and a required community consultation public meeting, it has been determined that the proposed Yorkville Village Core HCD Study Area merits authorization for study as a potential Heritage Conservation District.
