I am writing to express my firm opposition to designating the entire building at 506 Jarvis historical.

Since it was built in 1889, many historical features at 506 Jarvis Street were completely removed or rebuilt.

The back of 506 Jarvis includes an addition from the 1950s that contains no historical value.

Most of the windows were replaced in the last 30 years. The wood shingles were replaced in the last 20 years. The porch was extensively renovated in the last 30 years. The iron fence was also extensively replaced with a similar fence.

Gas lamps were added in the last 20 years.

I believe the front exterior of the building has historical value and agree that any construction to be done in the future should maintain the façade. The façade of the building should be designated as historical, and any changes preserved
