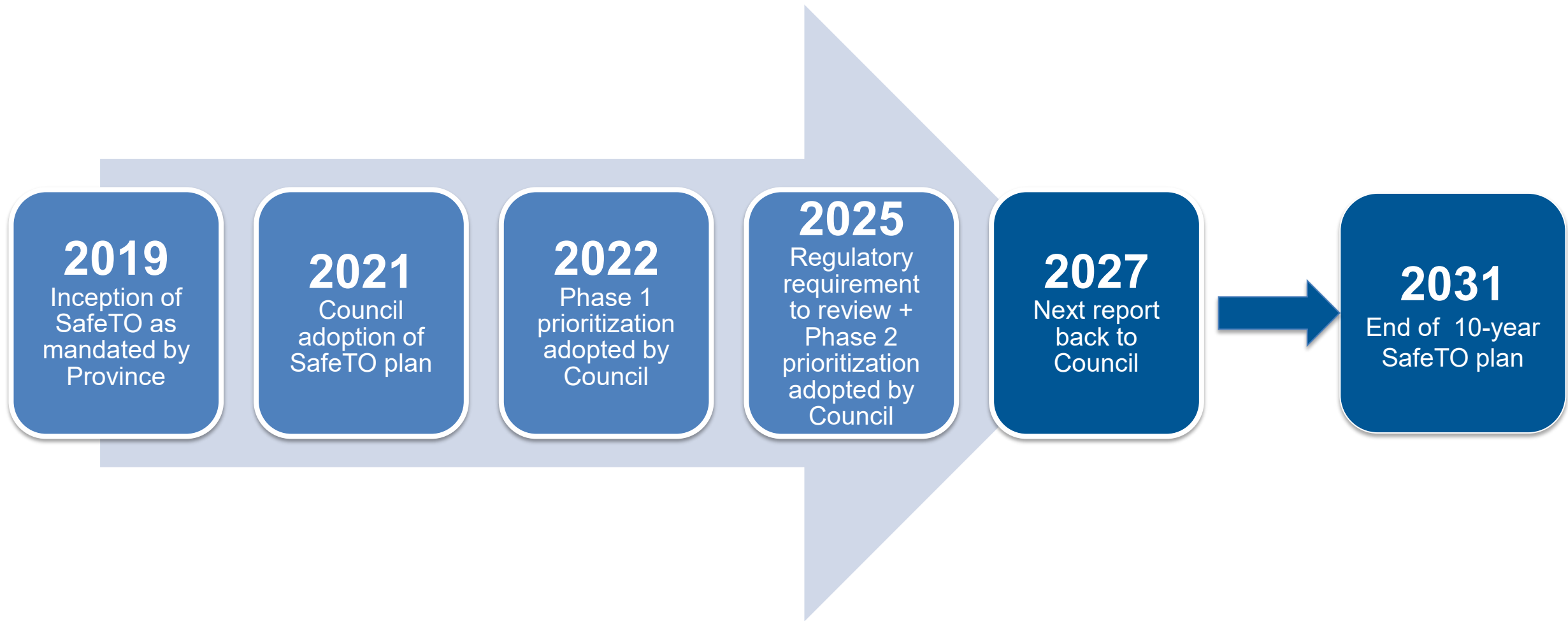

Action 3.2: Develop an implementation plan to guide the City's response to the calls for Justice from the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls



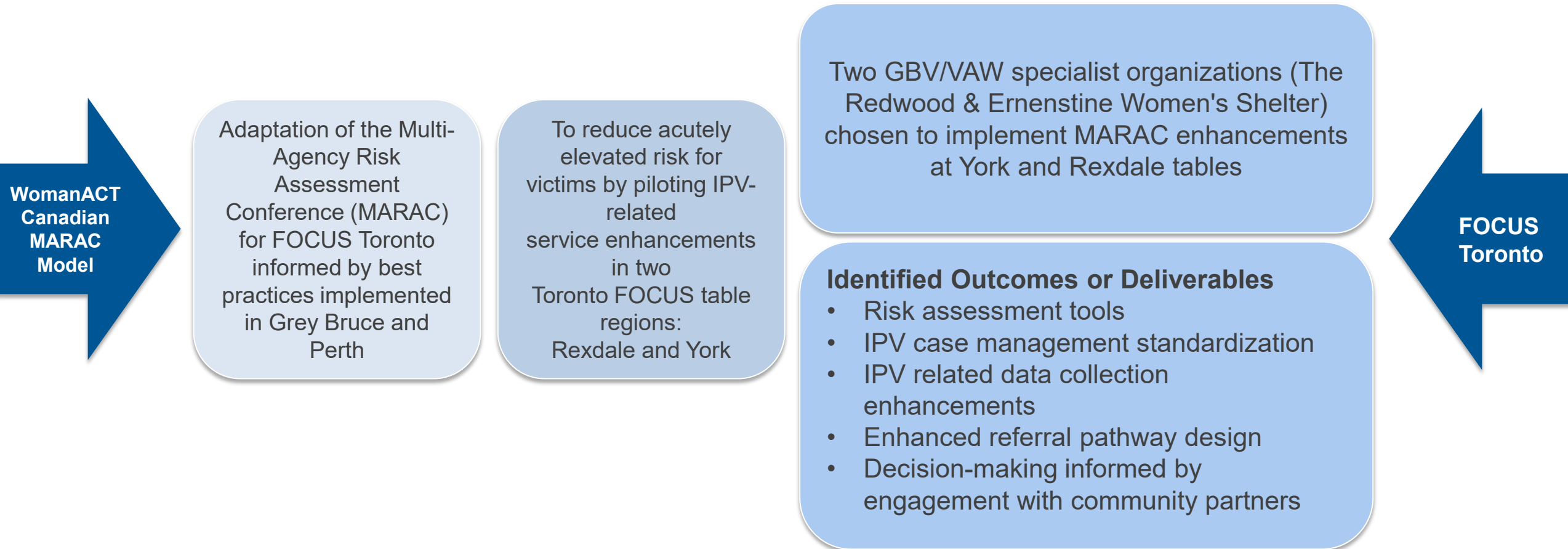
Action 5.1: Engage Residents and Build Community Capacity to Lead



Action 7.3: Strengthen Multi-Sector Collaboration through Partnership and Integrated Investments

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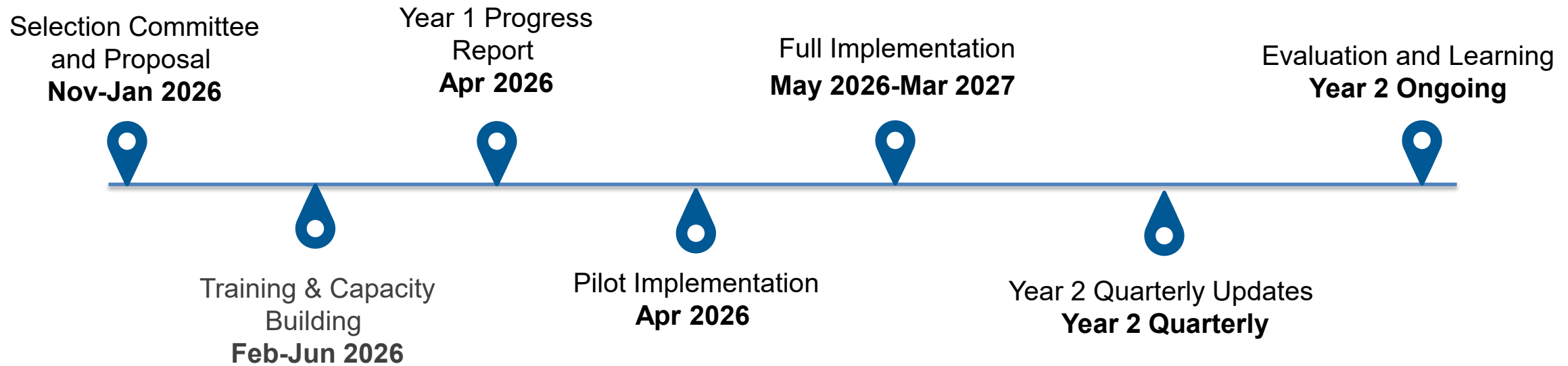
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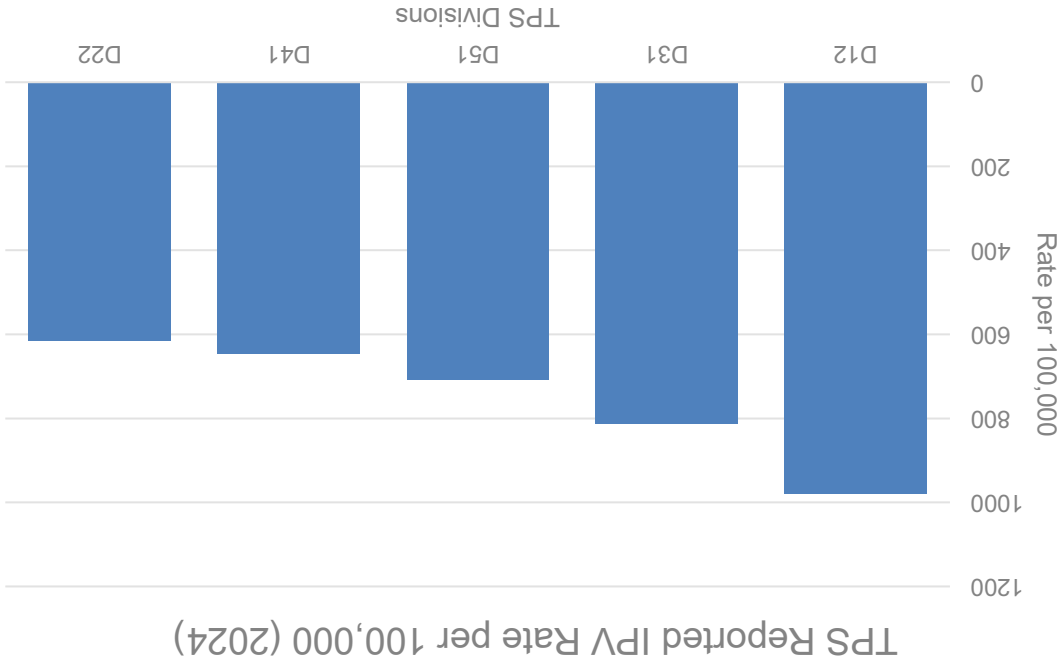

WomanACT & FOCUS Toronto Pilot Selection

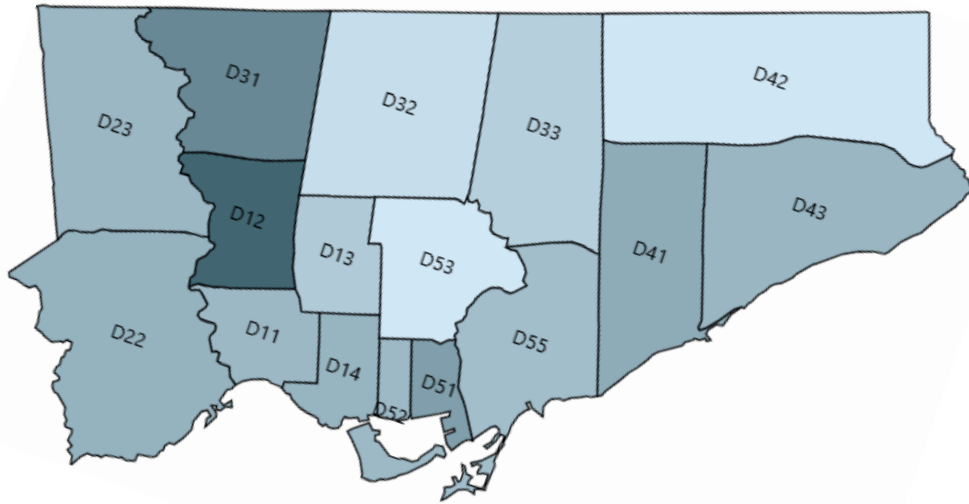


1. Comparative analysis of TPS OpenData IPV Dashboard and FOCUS Toronto DV Study Flagged Situations mapped by Table Regions.
2. Consultation with FOCUS Table Leads on GBV/IPV experiences at their tables
3. Consideration of external factors such as situation complexity and existing community resources

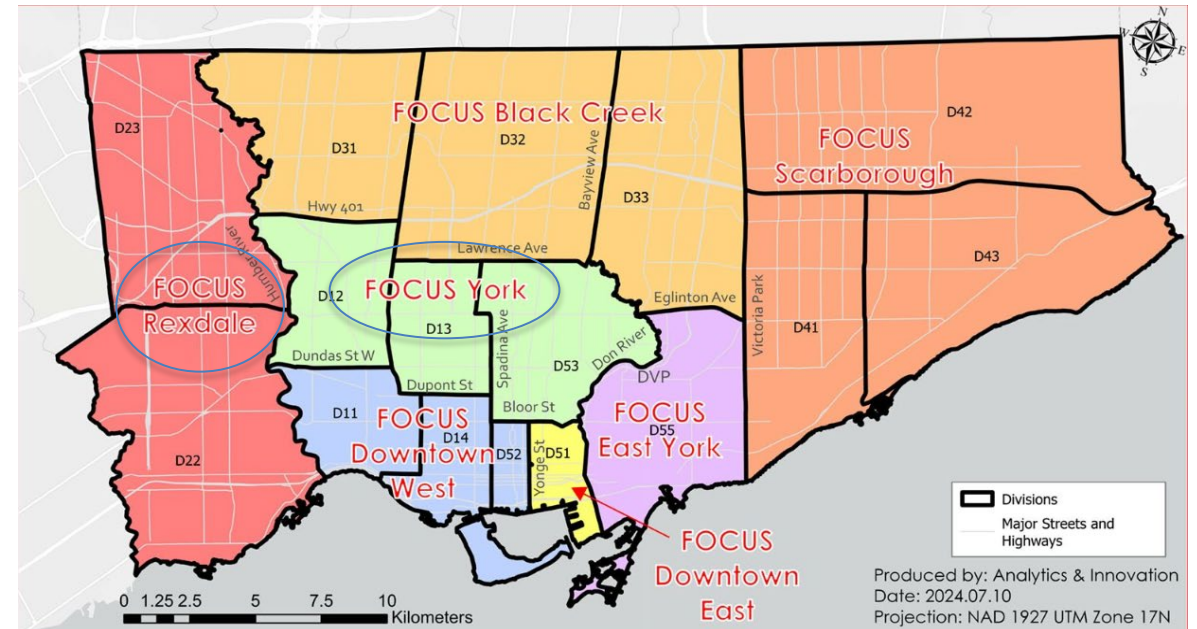
*2024 data used as Pilot sites were chosen in Q4 2025 without access to year-end data
