She worked as an occupational therapist, supporting children with a wide range of abilities and disabilities. Diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis in the early days of research and treatment, she was a fierce advocate for people with disabilities, lobbying for equal access, volunteering for the MS Society, and serving on the board of Hutton House in London, Ontario. Ms. Mandziuk's commitment to building and reinvesting in community inspired those around here, here in Canada and worldwide.
