REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report is about labour relations or employee negotiations.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval of a bargaining mandate for negotiations with IATSE Local B-173, which represents housekeeping staff at the Meridian Arts Centre.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The President and Chief Executive Officer recommends that the Board of Directors of TO Live:

1. Approve the bargaining mandate with IATSE Local B-173, as outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.
2. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains labour relations information or employee negotiations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact other than those outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.

DECISION HISTORY

At its December 12, 2023, meeting, the Board of Directors of TO Live approved the negotiated terms of the collective agreement with IATSE Local B-173 for housekeeping at the Meridian Arts Centre.
