Re: Parking Amendments - Waldock Street (24, Scarborough-Guildwood)

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 24 Councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present to the January 13, 2026, Scarborough Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

- Staff **support** the draft recommendations provided below
- Staff **do not support** the draft recommendations provided below
- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. *Scarborough Community Council amend the existing school bus loading zone, in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on Waldock Street, between a point 133 metres east of Galloway Road and a point 37 metres further east, to be in effect between a point 151.5 metres east of Galloway Road and a point 18.5 metres further east.*
2. *Scarborough Community Council amend the existing maximum 30-minutes parking regulation, in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between a point 90 metres east of Galloway Road and a point 43 metres further east, to be in effect between a point 90 metres east of Galloway Road and a point 61.5 metres further east.*

Transportation Services received a request from the Councillor's office to modify the existing school bus loading zone in front of Eastview Public School by reducing its length by half and instead designating that portion of the roadway for short term parking. Due to the urgency of the request, staff did not have sufficient time to undertake a detailed investigation of this matter.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations above will be approximately \$700.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Scarborough Community Council.
