Re: Re-opening Item SC27.12 - Ellington Drive - Accessible Loading Zone (Ward 21, Scarborough Centre)

Transportation Services has requested the Ward 21 Councillor to present the recommended wording to the January 13, 2026, Scarborough Community Council to re-open Item SC27.12 - Ellington Drive - Accessible Loading Zone. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

Draft Recommendations

1. *Scarborough Community Council Re-open Item SC27.12, titled "Ellington Drive - Accessible Loading Zone" with respect to Recommendation 1.*
2. *Scarborough Community Council delete Recommendation 1 of its decision on Item SC27.12 and adopt the following instead:*
 1. *Scarborough Community Council designate an accessible loading zone to be in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the east side of Ellington Drive, between a point 102 metres south of Guild Hall Drive and a point 13 metres further south.*

Scarborough Community Council, at its meeting on November 27, 2025, adopted Item SC27.12 - Ellington Drive - Accessible Loading Zone ([Agenda Item History - 2025.SC27.12](#)).

Further consultation with the applicant disclosed that the previously approved dimensions were not ideal and that a minor shift would improve the operation of the accessible loading zone. As the previous approval was less than one year ago, Council

procedures require that the previous item be re-opened and amended. Accordingly, Transportation Services is requesting that the accessible loading zone be slightly adjusted so that it includes the applicant's driveway, providing improved accommodation for accessible loading activities.

Financial Impact

Costs associated with the proposed relocation of the accessible loading zone, as approved under [Agenda Item History - 2025.SC27.12](#), remain unchanged. However, funding would now be subject to availability within Transportation Services 2026 Interim Operating Budget.
