**Re: Item SC28.12 - Corvette Avenue - Traffic Calming (Speed Humps)**

**BACKGROUND:**

Corvette Avenue is a local residential street near Corvette Junior Public School where concerns have been raised about speeding and road safety. Following a safety consultation with the school, the Councillor's office conducted direct outreach to nearby residents. A strong majority of surveyed residents expressed support for the installation of speed humps as a traffic calming measure and a means of improving overall safety for all users of Corvette. The proposed speed humps are intended to reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety for students, families, and the broader community.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that:

1. Scarborough Community Council authorize the installation of speed humps on Corvette Avenue between Kennedy Road and Magnolia Avenue
