I am submitting the following comments in connection with Item 2026.SC28.13, regarding the proposed Kingston Road and Kildonan Drive/Eastwood Avenue - Traffic Control Signals, to be considered by Scarborough Community Council.

I am writing in support of this item due to ongoing traffic safety concerns and the importance of improving access and safety for Legion members, visitors, and the surrounding community.

As a new mom in the neighbourhood, I have been at risk a number of times at the pedestrian crosswalk at Manderly and Kingston Road. While walking with my baby and dog, cars have not stopped, despite pressing the button and pointing. Given that Birch cliff is an up-and-coming family neighbourhood with young children and pets, we require a proper stoplight between warden and Birchcliff along Kingston Road. The current stoplight are far too spaced out. There is also a school with young children very close by this investment into the community would go a long way.
