SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend to City Council the appointment of a Council Member to fill a vacancy on the Aboriginal Affairs Advisory Committee, resulting from the resignation of Councillor Jennifer McKelvie, effective May 9, 2025.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of one Member of Council to the Aboriginal Affairs Advisory Committee for a term of office until November 14, 2026.

DECISION HISTORY

The Striking Committee, at its meeting on October 23, 2025, directed the City Clerk to conduct a new canvass of Members of Council for their interest in appointment to the Aboriginal Affairs Advisory Committee.
