Re: Tranmer Avenue - Parking Amendments (Ward 12, Toronto-St. Paul's)

Transportation Services has been requested by the Ward 12 Councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present to the February 19, 2026, Toronto and East York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations:

1. *Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing parking prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., on the south side of Tranmer Avenue, between Duplex Avenue and Avenue Road, to be in effect on the south side of Tranmer Avenue, between Duplex Avenue and Oriole Parkway.*
2. *Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation in effect from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., on the south side of Tranmer Avenue, between Duplex Avenue and Avenue Road, to be in effect on the south side of Tranmer Avenue, between Duplex Avenue and Oriole Parkway.*

In an effort to improve parking availability, the residents of Tranmer Avenue have submitted a petition to the Ward Councillor's office, requesting the rescission of the following existing parking regulations on the south side of Tranmer Avenue, between Avenue Road and Oriole Parkway:

- No parking, 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Monday to Friday; and
- Maximum one-hour time limit parking, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

These regulations have been in place for many years and likely pre-date amalgamation (1998).

Traffic Operations conducted a site visit in January 2026 to confirm the existing signage, verify parking regulations, and assess parking availability. Parking is currently prohibited at all times on the north side of Tranmer Avenue, between Avenue Road and Oriole Parkway. The existing road width of 8.5 metres is wide enough to accommodate parking on one side of Tranmer Avenue. Accordingly, it is feasible to permit parking on the south side, between Avenue Road and Oriole Parkway.

As there is demonstrated community support, Traffic Operations have no objections to the requested changes.

Financial Impact

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with approving the draft recommendations above will be approximately \$700.00. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Toronto and East York Community Council.
