Re: Main Street – Parking Amendments – Reopening item 2026.TE32.49

BACKGROUND:

Transportation Services staff have advised that a technical amendment is required with respect to Item 2026.TE32.49, titled 'Main Street – Parking Amendments.' Toronto and East York Community Council adopted the amendments on April 30, 2026; however, due to an administrative error, a street name was inadvertently excluded from one of the recommendations. As such, the item must be reopened and amended to correct the error.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council reopen Item 2026.TE32.49, titled "Main Street - Parking Amendments", with respect to Part 3 of the decision of Toronto and East York Community Council.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council delete Part 3 of its decision on Item 2026.TE32.49 and adopt the following:
 1. Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing 1-hour parking regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily, on the north and west side of Stephenson Avenue between Main Street and Morton Road, to be in effect on the north side of Stephenson Avenue between Morton Road and the laneway west of Main Street, north of Stephenson Avenue.
